His design/build model has received the American Institute of Architect's seal of approval.

Jauregui prides itself on creating custom homes, which is evident in the high level of detail and quality that goes into every build. The awards lining the office walls give testimony to the amazing accomplishments of this firm, including local, state and national recognition. In the last 25 years it has received more than 40 awards, including the 2004 Best in America Living Award, Texas Star Award 2003 Best Custom Luxury Home \$1 million to \$5 million and more than 30 Max Awards from the Homebuilders Association of Greater Austin.

"One of the things that makes the company unique is bringing so many disciplines under one roof," says Jauregui. "We've combined the disciplines of architectural design, interior design, construction
